## AT&T Wireless Service-Learning Scholarships

If you read about the underlying causes of homelessness in a sociology class, you are learning. If you volunteer at a homeless shelter, you are serving. Service-learning brings these two activities together so that you can consciously develop a deeper, more personal understanding of homelessness. Service-learning is a growing pedagogy that recognizes the benefits of active, engaged learning. There are examples of its application in all disciplines of the social sciences, the humanities and the natural sciences.

The College of Arts and Sciences Community Initiative (CI) is awarding several \$1000 scholarships to College of Arts and Sciences students who have done service-learning in connection with USF. To apply:

1. Complete the application coversheet.
2. Write an essay of at least 1000 words that describes the service you have performed and explains how you have integrated it into your classroom learning. Your essay will carry significant weight in the evaluation process; therefore, it should be well written and you should thoughtfully reflect upon the significance of your service-learning experience and its connection with your classroom learning.
3. Submit a letter from a College of Arts and Sciences faculty member in which he/she explains his/her involvement in your service-learning (use form).
4. Submit a letter from a community-based organization explaining their involvement in your service-learning (use form).
5. Submit a transcript (it can be unofficial).
